

Town of Medford Meeting of March 14, 2023

6:00 PM, Town Hall, W6462 Center Avenue

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Medford was called to order at 6:00 PM with the following present: Stanley Schmidt, Chairman, Rick Dowden, Justin Olson Supervisors, Carol Pernsteiner, Treasurer, Diane Maar, Clerk and Phil Curran, Road Superintendent.

Review Financial Condition

Checking account balance as of February 28, 2023, is \$275,857.81. Total in all saving/Checking and CD accounts is \$596,999.80. Motion was made by Olson, seconded by Dowden to accept the Treasurer's report as read. All in favor. All Aye. **Motion Carried.**

Approval of the Minutes

Motion was made by Dowden seconded by Schmidt to approve the minutes from the February 14, 2023 meeting. All in favor. All Aye. **Motion Carried.**

Audit/Approval of Vouchers

Motion was made by Dowden, seconded by Olson to approve vouchers 10672– 10711. All in favor. All Aye. **Motion Carried.**

Road Maintenance

Sanding, salting and plowing are being done as needed. Road limits were posted today. The first layer of blacktop will be placed down on Castle Road in June. Chairman Schmidt met with Taylor County Highway Commissioner Benjamin Stanfley regarding the Center Ave bridge project. Taylor County solicited bids for an engineer for the Center Ave Bridge project. After review, it was determined that Cooper Engineering bid will be accepted.

Certified Survey Applications

Dowden moved, Olson seconded a motion to recommend to approve the certified survey application for Kevin Filipiak and Paul Spanbauer for additional land to be added to existing 5 acres owned by Spanbauer (house encroachment), remaining Filipiak land. All in Favor. All Aye. **Motion Carried.**
