

Town of Medford Meeting of April 14, 2026

Open Meeting Law Compliance

Review Financial Condition

Opening of Bids

Bids were solicited for 5/8" and 3/4" blue/gray granite and 3/4" crushed gravel. Results are as follows: Haas Sons, Inc - \$13.36/ton 3/4" blue-gray granite; \$13.61/ton 5/8" blue-gray granite; \$14.96/yd 3/4" crushed gravel. Dennis Oryn Trucking -- \$15.00/ton 3/4" blue-gray granite; \$15.00/ton 5/8" blue-gray granite. James Peterson Sons, Inc. - \$20.09/yd 3/4" crushed gravel. Melvin Companies - \$17.40/yd 3/4" crushed gravel. Olson moved, Dowden seconded a motion to accept the bids from Haas Sons, Inc for all gravel bids. All in favor. All Aye. **Motion Carried.**

Bids were solicited for LRIP project #18911 for Perkinstown Avenue paving in two lifts approximately 10,630 feet from County Road E east to Castle. Result as follows: American Asphalt of Wisconsin \$408,210. Olson moved; Dowden seconded a motion to accept the bid from American Asphalt. All in favor. All Aye. **Motion Carried.**

Road Maintenance

Received letter from DOT stating LRIP project on the Jolly application wasn't selected for funding. The new traffic counter has arrived, Phil will get it added to our insurance policy. Phil started road grading.
